Routliffe, a local designer, photographer and video artist, has been serving clients through his company Thornapple Productions for the past 8 years and has been teaching for nearly as long.

The course requirements are basic computer skills and a laptop with Photoshop installed. You will learn the many uses of Photoshop, a walk around of its tools and the art of manipulating an image to create your own visual work of art. As well, it includes a lesson and assignment.
